Tuesday 6th February

After your morning buffet breakfast we drive just 20 minutes from the city center to **Summit Green Valley Golf Course**. A world class visually stunning course surrounded by Palms and lakes with modern club house facilities. Enjoy a drink after golf and your evening exploring Chiang Mai city.



Wednesday 7th February

A day at your own leisure or **optional** full day tour. The tour starts with a visit to the Elephant camp, then Lunch at Butterfly Orchid farm followed by a visit the beautiful Doi Suthep Temple high in the mountains.



Thursday 8th February

Today we travel around 45 minutes to **The Royal Chiang Mai Golf Club.**Designed by Peter Thompson, the design is reminiscent of a traditional British Parkland course with some interesting "links" additions. Set within beautiful mountain backdrops it has a few challenging holes but offers all levels of golfers an enjoyable round with a chance to score well.





Friday 9th February

After breakfast you will picked up by our air-conditioned mini bus and drive approximately 2 hours through the country side. We will stop for a delicious Thai style buffet lunch then shortly after travel by long tail boat through the majestic mountains passing elephants and villages along the way. Finally arriving in Chiang Rai where we check into the centrally located Wiang Inn hotel. Enjoy the evening at your leisure exploring the markets, restaurants and bars.







Saturday 10th February

Today we take an exciting adventure to explore the Golden Triangle, Three countries in one day!! First we travel to the view point overlooking the Mekong river and take in the magnificent views of Laos, Myanmar and China in the distance. We then depart by boat and enter Laos where the local markets are buzzing with designer labels and interesting souvenirs. From there its on to the Opium Museum to discover the history of the Golden Triangle. A buffet lunch and finally arriving at Myanmar, where we experience a village of shops and markets. Back to your hotel about 6pm.





Sunday 11th February

Get ready to experience one of the top golf courses in Thailand. Today we play **Santiburi Golf Course.** Owned by the Singha Beer company and kept in stunning condition year round, Santiburi is home to many championship events. There are many natural features on this course including 2 large lakes and rolling hills, each hole cleverly designed into the contours of the valleys. After golf enjoy a drink and a meal while overlooking the course.





Monday 12th February


Your day at leisure, enjoy some local tasty food and relax with a massage. **Optional** tour to the White Temple or golf.
